PLAN:

The investigation of the wetting agent consisted of conducting a product conformance evaluation and performance testing as described in NFPA 18 and applicable portions of UL 162.

DESCRIPTION

PRODUCT COVERED:

Super Cold Fire and Flame Out wetting agents.

CONSTRUCTION DETAILS:
