Taylor Gas Plant Experiences a Loss of Burning Liquids



All is good here again thanks to the Fire Caddy.

We experienced a situation at our plant where a large amount of fuel was dumped to our flare stack but our flare was unable to burn all of the fuel before it hit the ground. When the burning fuel hit the ground it caused a large grass fire approx two to three acres in size.

With the fire caddy in tow we hurried to the area, pulled down the fence and started the Fire Caddy up. Even though our Fire Caddy has two attack hoses, a single line was good enough.

Once the Flame Out was turned on we had the fire out in less than 5 minutes from the time of arrival to the last flame. Yes, we used a higher quantity of flame out than was required to put out the fire but to be sure we could not afford to have this fire get out of control.

This is the second fire we have had to put out with the Fire Caddy and well I can tell you now that our local fire dept is a little disappointed as they have not been able to come to our site for any play time since we have gotten this machine.
